In today's dark world, shedding light on important issues is more crucial than ever. One issue is the prevalence of abuse within certain so-called 'reformatory' institutions, here named the 'Troubled Teen Industry' (the TTI).

This is a series of programs that coerce vulnerable parents into subjecting their children to years of traumatic abuse, for profit.

Our goals will be simple and direct, our methods strictly non-violent, safety will be maintained by our policies, we are adamant about achieving our goals.

SALVATION PURPOSE STATEMENT

A1 Spotlight the TTI:

We will create a series of videos that expose the realities of TTI facilities such as Tranquility Bay, High Impact and other camps worldwide accused of ongoing mistreatment of minors.

We are embarking on missions to visit TTI facilities, as did the Netflix group who produced 'the Program'. We will carry this out independently.

This will be a journalistic based endeavour bringing together independent talent from the survivor community to visit and detail each experience, in person.

A2 Support for Survivors:

Delving into the experiences of survivors and advocating for change, we will also provide a platform of catharsis and healing for the survivors of the program, during our process. We have been creating, connecting and supporting a plethora of supportive functions and services for survivors, as well as pursuing our visits. We will provide for those who suffered under the TTI a safe connection to their past, with the tools they need to properly heal and a community that will support them.

A3 Bring Change Worldwide:

Incorporating alliances with legal and research teams, third party supporters, political representatives, voting and lobbying groups, concerned citizens and more, we will put an end to programs of this kind, through common awareness, financial divestment, legal action and disclusion.

There still a number of torturous facilities online, many run by the same people that began this incidious business plan. They still profit from this pain each day.

Right now as children are face down in cells, we are collating our intelligence and devining a plan to bring them down for good.

Tranquility Bay, a former WWASP campus in Jamaica, has been the subject of scrutiny and controversy due to allegations of abuse & mistreatment of its students, medical mal-practice and more. Former attendees have recounted harrowing tales of physical, sexual, emotional, and psychological abuse endured during their time at the institution. People died here: This story needs telling.

Despite numerous investigations and reports exposing these atrocities, justice for the victims has been elusive, and the cycle of abuse persists.

PRIMARY OBJECTIVES - EXPANDED

In a historic unearthing, we are headed to TB2, first, with dedicated teams: We will take time to personally re-process our tragic history and document for the world what went on there, returning with true survivors of the facility to make their testimony known and take steps towards letting go.

This is one example of many mobilized projects lined up by Salvation, all aimed at producing a portfolio of material poised at spotlighting, care-taking and renewal. We will bring back the hard truth, on film.

We have created a number of technologic and social provisions to support survivors. Calling on councilors and our own mediators, we stress the importance of psychological, emotional, & intellectual support, at this time of remembrance.

We will continue this work to also provide technology, facilities, safe spaces, education, training, comradery, an avenue to non-violent action and more.

For most of us this process has been more challenging than anything before.

We will continue to facilities High Impact, Casa-by-Sea, Paradise Cove, Dundee Ranch and the Morava Academy. These 6 targets demonstrate the ills of locating uncertified and unsupervised corporately-run facilities for children in overseas realms. They also knit a concise framework through ownership, corporate structure, assets and political alliances.

The truth is shocking. By shining a light on the dark truths hidden within these walls, we aim to prompt meaningful dialogue, inspire action, and ultimately prevent future generations from suffering similar injustices.

NO For maximum inertia on these tasks, we need your support.

Our campaign aims to raise funds for flights, food, and medical supplies, cameras, tech gear and all the necessary services for this impactful series of visits. We will require tech services, specialized cargo, cards and batteries, the works and have so far agreed much of it can come straight out of our pockets.

We have turned down media outlets or lisencing, remain independent so as to preserve the truth and our journalistic integrity.

A CALL FOR FUNDING

Funding is set up here to top tier standards in environmental, training, equipment sustenance, safety, dexterity and more. This rundown equates costs for:

While here we cover flights, medical expenses, food and sustenance, and tech gear, there are many expenses not listed here, personal gear and all the many hours this has taken behind the scenes. We are going. How we go is up to our fundraising!

TRAVEL EXPENSES:

Traveling to Jamaica and other locations pertinent to the story is imperative for conducting interviews with survivors, gathering first-hand accounts and documenting in the environment in which the abuse occurred.

Funding will cover airfare, accommodation, transportation, carriage, staff and logistical expenses associated with travel.

This will include fares incurred in order to bring those with medical & mobility issues with us. This also may include specialized cargo & carriage, rental vehicles and payroll for human assets such as drivers and guides.

If camping is involved this may include modest shelter.

We are expecting the flights to be the worst news in all this though be advised we may need to fly assets around prior to the visits, have some congregate and fly together, request units to form up for training, and more. This will all require a significant consideration or come out of pocket.

This breaks down into a sustenance package we take with us for basics and emergency use, a fare for cheap daily choices and meals on while the move, water and cookware, along with carriage, plus two decent suppers out for our people.

FOOD & SUSTAINANCE:

Ensuring the well-being of our team members during filming is paramount.

Body, mind and spirit must be kept in high levels of maintainance.

This is no ordinary day out.

Adequate nutrition is essential for maintaining energy levels and mental clarity, enabling us to focus on the task at hand. We must maintain our health regarding diet considering the varied other factors affecting us.

Your contributions will help cover the costs of meals and sustenance throughout the duration of the project, taking stress off of procurement; making our chow plans a breeze.

Special diets will be tended to and our food will meet a standard of safety and health.

We will indeed enjoy a celebration supper, and will ensure we select some program food for filming.

This article contains all requirements to cook and clean as well as water purification. Modest outdoor cookware and snack items may also be purchased from this fund.

A CALL FOR FUNDING

MEDICAL SUPPLIES:

Given the remoteness of the locations, the geologic & climatic differences, wildlife, the emotionally charged nature of the subject matter, the opposing forces at hand and the potential challenges encountered during filming, it is essential to prioritize the health and safety of our team.

Funding will be allocated towards acquiring necessary medical supplies, including first aid kits, medications, various response kits and access to medical professionals where needed.

We will equip a vehicle as a makeshift ambulance and have medical professionals on site at all times.

We will not compromise our survivor's safety and medical gear is a priority.

Our trained medics will go fully equipped, special gear will be purchased and no one will be without their medications.

As well as all this, each of us will carry an Individual First Aid Kit (IFAK), with comfort items and emotional gear available. Off site medical response will be advised of our presence once we arrive.

With a modest capture crew we'll still require at least four decent cameras with kit, powerful laptops, varied lights, tripods and all the chargers and connectors in order we suffer no latency regarding what we can shoot and when.

Choice lenses, the batteries and cards will be requested, a nifty bit of carriage gear, plan-Bs for all important tools and around fifty kilos of wardrobe and props.

Naturally some of our survivors come with some kit, a Canon 7D here, a small drone there. We would however like to superfund what we have to ensure security and quality.

For this mission we will want our drones as well as surveillance gear and listening equipment. Academic hardware may include a projector, a number of binders and pens, printing fees and other miscellaneous items.

Media may hire one or more film-makers, directors, writers, animators, video editors, etc for planning, ground works and or post-production.

Ground expenses incurred specifically by the media team may be retrieved from this fund including costs for access to intel or sources, interview overheads, and more.

Naturally hardware remaining from this trip will be carried on, mitigating repeat spending.
